Through this petition, Muhammad Suleman petitioner seeks post arrest bail in case FIR No.238 dated 03.08.2017 registered for offence under Section 295-C of Pakistan Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Chuchak, District Okara.

2. The allegation against the petitioner as per contents of the crime report is that on 02.08.2017 at 12:30 p.m. he tore the flex/poster containing the scription of 'Labbaik Ya Rasool Allah' as well as pictures of 'Khana Kaaba' and 'Roza-e-Rasool' and threw the same in the drain line.

3. Arguments heard. Record perused.

4. The petitioner is specifically nominated in the crime report with the allegation of an offence which falls within the prohibitory clause of Section 497 of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898. Statements of Muhammad Shakeel and Muhammad Shahzad, witnesses recorded under Section 161 of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898, support the narration of crime report. During investigation, the petitioner has been found

connected with the alleged offence. Challan of this case stands sent to the learned trial court and the trial is fixed for prosecution evidence on 17.03.2017. Per relevant column of report under Section 173 of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898, prosecution has only five witnesses to produce before the learned trial court which transpires that the conclusion of trial is in sight.

For all the above mentioned reasons, this Court is not inclined to grant post arrest bail to the petitioner hence, this petition is dismissed. However, the learned trial court is directed to proceed with the trial expeditiously to ensure its swift conclusion preferably within a period of three months after receipt of this order.
